**ORDERS OF THE DAY  
RE-COMMITTAL OF BILLS**

1. Re-Committal of Bills to the Committee of the Whole.

*The Senate:*

*Recalls* that the following Bills were passed by the Senate and the House of Representatives and were transmitted to the Clerk of the National Assembly for onward transmission to the President C-in-C for Assent;

The Bills are:

1. National Examination Council (NECO) Bill, 2023;
2. National Drug Law Enforcement Agency (Amendment) Act, 2023;
3. Physically Challenged (Empowerment) Act, 2023;
4. Chartered Institute of Digital Forensic of Nigeria Bill, 2023;
5. Federal College of Education (Technical), Ako, Ago-Iwoye, Ogun State Bill, 2023;
6. Control of Small Arms and Light Weapons Bill, 2023;
7. National Assembly Library Trust Fund (Establishment) Act, 2023; and
8. Federal College of Education (Technical) Aghoro, Bayelsa State Bill, 2023;

*Accordingly resolves to:*

*Rescind* its decision on the Bills as passed and re-commit same to the Committee of the Whole for re-consideration and passage.
